- Invest in a good and appropriate IT to monitor loan portfolio.

- Adoption and Adherence to Prudential Standards. (PEARLS and COOP-PESOS, GLARES, CAMELS)

- Partner and collaborate with your Federation to ensure CUs can serve their members better.
- Self-regulation builds members confidence to your CUs.
- Self regulation leads to sustainability.
