Introduction

Credit unions are made up of cooperators and they operate on the basis of cooperative principles and values - the underpinning differentiation of credit unions with other financial cooperatives. Cooperatives and credit unions are based on the values of self-help, self-responsibility, democracy, equality, equity, and solidarity. In the tradition of their founders, cooperative members believe in the ethical values of honesty, openness, social responsibility and caring for others. The values in itself provide basis for credit unions to exude good governance organization.

Objectives

CULEG is an opinion on relative standing of a credit union organization with regard to adoption of the 11 principles of good governance practices. The training is aimed at providing skills to credit union trainers and technical consultants enabling them to use tool as benchmark for rating the level of governance of a credit union. The credit unions can also use the tool as an input to their annual Board retreat. The tool alerts the credit union on the areas to focus rather than “cookie cutter” approach.

Who should attend & How to Apply?

ACCU anticipates that the training curriculum will be part of the training for all leaders and employees of credit unions. Target participants are:
